Thanks to desalination devices installed on board there is no worry for a short of fresh water during the cruise.

Sailing plans for the cruise:

- Practical familiarisation with frigate rigging, training in yard works,
- Yards sails building, putting and setting lessons,
- Coordination of sailing manoeuvres, stern and stay turns,
- Keeping navigation watches,
- Possible familiarisation with work and service of navigation devices,
- Keeping machine watches, possible visit in the engine room of the "Gift of Youth",
- Optional trainings for volunteers in form of talks and presentations,
- Social meetings, common sailing songs performances in the mess-room.

Draft agenda of this year's cruise:

- 11 March since 09:00 embarkation,
- 11 March familiarisation with sailing ship, introductory yards training.
- 12 March putting to sea, familiarisation with alarm signals,
- 12 14 March practical exercises in setting and furling sails, stern and stay turns, etc.
- 14 17 March passage through Kattegat and Skagerrak strait to the North Sea.
- 17 March IV Sailing Song Contest Skagen 2013 (during the cruise)
- 17 22 March sailing in the North Sea, practical exercises in setting and furling sails, stern and stay turns, etc.
- 22 March entry to Antwerp port
- 23 March 09:00 debarkation of the crew

All the sailors (trainees) taking part in the cruise are subjected to the same rules and will be charged with the same duties as any other trainees of the "Gift of Youth". These duties include not only works related to operating sails or keeping watches but also support works in the kitchen and meals collecting premises as well as cleaning works.

Every participant is also obliged to respect the ship regulations and the day's agenda and every day (excepting Saturday and Sunday) starts with compulsory morning workout.

The observance of the ship regulations and customs is of utmost importance so we kindly ask you to take it seriously from the beginning.

Please keep in mind that there will be almost 150 persons on board and the watch officer has to be sure at every moment that everyone is safe and sound and that all are well aboard.
