

IPA UK: Las Vegas Mass Shooting - Seminar



Section UK is pleased to announce that it has arranged for Detective Ken Mead from the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department Southern Nevada Counter Terrorism Centre to deliver a presentation into the 2017 mass shooting incident in Las Vegas.

Detective Mead's presentation is based on the official multiagency debrief/learning the lesson report into the 01/10/2017 incident where 58 people at the Route 91 Harvest Music Festival were killed by an active shooter.

The unique opportunity to see this presentation will be of interest to officers and staff in particular those front line officers and staff, armed officers and commanders along with detectives and those involved in the setting of crime investigative strategy and providing the initial police response.

Detective Mead is a decorated serving officer who was a first responder to the scene with his Joint Terrorism Task Force and who post incident worked on the investigation team. He was subsequently awarded a Commendation Medal for his work on the case, his credibility to deliver this certainly speaks for itself.

The presentation will cover; Special Events in Las Vegas – Route 91 Harvest Music Festival – Shots Fired – Communications – Police and Fire Response – Command and Control – Intelligence gathering – Steven Paddock/Marliou Danley – Crime Scenes – Investigative findings and intent – Aftermath – Media – Lessons to be learned

The same presentation will be delivered during an afternoon session on the 15th October 2019 and a morning session on 16th October 2019, as follows.
